Good News about the Governor's mask update for schools! "After March 11, in schools and child care facilities, masks will not be required but will be strongly recommended. Masks will still be required for everyone in high transmission settings like public transit, emergency shelters, health care settings, correctional facilities, homeless shelters and long-term care facilities. As always, local jurisdictions may have additional requirements beyond the state guidance". We are hopeful this means students and staff are no longer mandated to wear masks here at Crestview.
